







Volunteering Rates in 2022




Average Hours Volunteered in 2022 by Age Group




Anticipated Volunteer Activities for 2023




Planning to Volunteer More Hours, With More Organizations or Both in 2023




Experiences with Remote Volunteering




- I have and will continue to volunteer remotely

- I have not participated and do not plan on it




Volunteers Who Would Consider Virtual Volunteering






Skills People Want to Use when Volunteering
